## BASIC PRINCIPALS IN RIGHT DIVISION

### HOW TO UNDERSTAND THE WORD OF GOD

The KEY to unlock an understanding of God's Word is

**2 Tim 2:15** Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth.

Just WHAT does the verse mean?

There are 2 basic ways in which the Bible is taught ---

**Allegorically** (mystical, just 'get the idea or main thought' and spiritualize it)

or **Literally** (it means what it says .... and it says what it means, the exact WORDS are important)

### **Here are the 3 BASIC DIVISIONS:**

They are as SIMPLE as: PAST PRESENT FUTURE

**Eph 2:11-13** Wherefore remember, that ye being **in time past** Gentiles in the flesh, who are called Uncircumcision by that which is called the Circumcision in the flesh made by hands;

12 That at that time ye were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in the world:

13 **But now** in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.

**Eph 2:7** That in **the ages to come** he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.

## PAUL IS OUR APOSTLE

Rom 11:13 For I speak to you Gentiles, inasmuch as I am the apostle of the Gentiles, I magnify mine office:

1 Tim 2:7 Whereunto I am ordained a preacher, and an apostle, (I speak the truth in Christ, and lie not;) a teacher of the Gentiles in faith and verity.

2 Tim 1:11 Whereunto I am appointed a preacher, and an apostle, and a teacher of the Gentiles.

## PETER IS THEIR CHIEF APOSTLE

Matt 16:18-19 And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock (Peter's confession that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God.) I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it.

19 And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven.

Gal 2:9 And when James, Cephas, and John, who seemed to be pillars, perceived the grace that was given unto me, they gave to me and Barnabas the right hands of fellowship; that we should go unto the heathen, and they unto the circumcision. (Here, James, Peter (John 1:42), and John agreed with Paul that they would confine their ministry to the JEWS.)

**SALVATION - Gift of God**

**Rom 5:18** Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life.

**Rom 6:23** For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.

**Eph 2:8** For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God:

**SALVATION - Animal Sacrifices**

**Lev 17:11** For the life of the flesh is in the blood: and I have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls: for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul.

**SALVATION - Water Baptism**

**Mark 16:16** He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

**SALVATION - Keep the Commandments and Sell ALL You Have**

**Matt 19:16-21** And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, **what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life?**

17 And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? there is none good but one, that is, God: but **if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments**.

18 He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness,

19 Honour thy father and thy mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself.

20 The young man saith unto him, All these things have I kept from my youth up: what lack I yet?

21 Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go and sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come and follow me.

**NOT of WORKS**

**Eph 2:9** Not of works, lest any man should boast.

**Titus 3:5-6** Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;  
6 Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Saviour;

**Rom 11:6** And if by grace, then is it no more of works: otherwise grace is no more grace. But if it be of works, then is it no more grace: otherwise work is no more work.

**WORKS Required**

**Acts 10:35** But in every nation he that feareth him, and worketh righteousness, is accepted with him.

**Deut 6:25** And it shall be our righteousness, IF we observe to DO all these commandments before the LORD our God, as he hath commanded us.

**RANSOM for ALL**

**1 Tim 2:5-6** For there is one God, and one mediator between God and men, the man Christ Jesus;

6 Who gave himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.

**2 Cor 5:15** And that he died for all, that they which live should not henceforth live unto themselves, but unto him which died for them, and rose again.

**RANSOM for MANY**

**Matt 20:28** Even as the Son of man came not to be ministered unto, but to minister, and to give his life a ransom for many.

**Matt 26:28** For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

**JUSTIFIED by GRACE**

**Rom 3:24** Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

**Titus 3:7** That being justified by his grace, we should be made heirs according to the hope of eternal life.

**JUSTIFIED by FAITH**

**Rom 3:28** Therefore we conclude that a man is justified by faith without the deeds of the law.

**Rom 5:1-2** Therefore being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ:

2 By whom also we have access by faith into this grace wherein we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

**Gal 2:16** Knowing that a man is not justified by the works of the law, but by the faith of Jesus Christ, even we have believed in Jesus Christ, that we might be justified by the faith of Christ, and not by the works of the law: for by the works of the law shall no flesh be justified.

**Gal 3:10** For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse: for it is written, Cursed is every one that continueth not in all things which are written in the book of the law to do them.

### **JUSTIFIED by WORKS**

**James 2:24** Ye see then how that by works a man is justified, and not by faith only.

**Gal 5:4** Christ is become of no effect unto you, whosoever of you are justified by the law; ye are fallen from grace.

### **OUGHT TO WALK BY GRACE (by choice)**

**Col 2:6** As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him:

**Phil 3:16-17** Nevertheless, whereto we have already attained, let us walk by the same rule, let us mind the same thing.

17 Brethren, be followers together of me (Paul), and mark them which walk so as ye have us for an ensample.

**1 Thess 4:1** Furthermore then we beseech you, brethren, and exhort you by the Lord Jesus, that as ye have received of us how ye ought to walk and to please God, so ye would abound more and more.

### **MUST WALK IN OBEDIENCE**

**Ezek 36:27** And I will put my spirit within you, and **cause you to walk in my statutes**, and ye shall keep my judgments, and DO them.

**Ezek 37:24** And David my servant shall be king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe my statutes, and do them.

**1 John 1:7** But IF we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin.

## **There are 2 Locations God is Concerned With:**

**Gen 1:1** In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.

---

## **Now, let's look at some ISSUES in BOTH PLACES:**

**HEAVEN**

**1 Cor 15:49** And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.

(We are going UP)

**1 Thess 4:14-17** For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him.

15 For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

16 For the Lord himself shall descend from heaven with a shout, with the voice of the archangel, and with the trump of God: and the dead in Christ shall rise first:

17 Then we which are alive and remain shall be caught up together with them in the clouds, to meet the Lord in the air: and so shall we ever be with the Lord. (We will stay up there .... in the air .... in heaven .... with the Lord.)

(Positionally speaking .... we're already there!)

**Eph 2:5-6** Even when we were dead in sins, hath quickened us together with Christ, (by grace ye are saved;)

6 And hath raised us up together, and made us sit together in heavenly places in Christ Jesus:

**EARTH**

**Psa 115:16** The heaven, even the heavens, are the LORD'S: but the earth hath he given to the children of men.

(The nation Israel gets the 'Promised Land' forever.)

**Exo 32:13** Remember Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, thy servants, to whom thou swarest by thine own self, and saidst unto them, I will multiply your seed as the stars of heaven, and all this land that I have spoken of will I give unto your seed, and they shall inherit it for ever.

**Zeph 2:3** Seek ye the LORD, all ye meek of the earth, which have wrought his judgment; seek righteousness, seek meekness: it may be ye shall be hid in the day of the LORD'S anger.

**Matt 5:5** Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth. (This verse is a quote from Psa 37:11.) (Jesus said He is meek in Matt 11:29.)

(In the future, Jesus will move DOWN to the earth to live here.)

**Zech 8:3** Thus saith the LORD; I am returned unto Zion, and will dwell in the midst of Jerusalem: and Jerusalem shall be called a city of truth; and the mountain of the LORD of hosts the holy mountain.

**HEAVENLY KINGDOM**

**2 Tim 4:18** And the Lord shall deliver me from every evil work, and will preserve me unto his heavenly kingdom: to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.

**EARTHLY KINGDOM**

**Dan 2:44** And in the days of these kings shall the God of heaven set up a kingdom, which shall never be destroyed: and the kingdom shall not be left to other people, but it shall break in pieces and consume all these kingdoms, and it shall stand for ever.

**2 Sam 7:16-17** And thine house and thy kingdom shall be established for ever before thee: thy throne shall be established for ever.

17 According to all these words, and according to all this vision, so did Nathan speak unto David.

**Luke 1:31-33** And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS.

32 He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:

33 And he shall reign over the house of Jacob for ever; and of his kingdom there shall be no end.

**Rev 21:2-3** And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

3 And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God.

**MYSTERY**

**Eph 3:3-5** How that by revelation he made known unto me (Paul) the mystery; (as I wrote afore in few words,

4 Whereby, when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ)

5 Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit;

**Eph 3:9** And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:

**Rom 16:25-26** Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my **(Paul's)** gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began,

26 But now is made manifest, and by the scriptures of the prophets, according to the commandment of the everlasting God, made known to all nations for the obedience of faith:

**PROPHECY**

**Luke 1:68-70** Blessed be the Lord God of Israel; for he hath visited and redeemed his people,

69 And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David;

70 As he spake by the mouth of his holy prophets, which have been since the world began:

**Acts 3:21** Whom the heaven must receive until the times of restitution of all things, which God hath spoken by the mouth of all his holy prophets since the world began.

---

**GOD'S PEOPLE ARE THE BODY OF CHRIST (Neither Jew nor Gentile)**

**1 Cor 12:27** Now ye are the body of Christ, and members in particular.

**Rom 10:12** For there is no difference between the Jew and the Greek: for the same Lord over all is rich unto all that call upon him.

**Rom 12:5** So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another.

**Eph 1:22-23** And hath put all things under his feet, and gave him to be the head over all things to the church,

23 Which is his body, the fulness of him that filleth all in all.

**Gal 3:28** There is neither Jew nor Greek, there is neither bond nor free, there is neither male nor female: for ye are all one in Christ Jesus.

**GOD'S PEOPLE ARE ISRAEL (Then there WAS a difference between them & us)**

**Deut 7:6** For thou art an holy people unto the LORD thy God: the LORD thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth.

**Exo 19:5-6** Now therefore, if ye will obey my voice indeed, and keep my covenant, then ye shall be a peculiar treasure unto me above all people: for all the earth is mine:

6 And ye shall be unto me a kingdom of priests, and an holy nation. These are the words which thou shalt speak unto the children of Israel.

---

---

## **FORGIVENESS**

**Eph 1:7** In whom we HAVE redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

**Eph 4:32** And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake HATH forgiven you.

**Col 1:14** In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins:

**Col 2:13** And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having (already) forgiven you all trespasses;

## **FORGIVENESS**

**Matt 6:14-15** For IF ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you:

15 But IF ye forgive NOT men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses.

**1 John 1:9** IF we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

---

## **GIVING (NOT tithing)**

**2 Cor 9:7** Every man according as he purposeth in his heart, so let him give; not grudgingly, or of necessity: for God loveth a cheerful giver.

## **TITHING**

**Mal 3:8-11** Will a man rob God? Yet ye have robbed me. But ye say, Wherein have we robbed thee? In tithes and offerings.

9 Ye are cursed with a curse: for ye have robbed me, even **this whole nation.**

10 Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be **meat** in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.

**Mal 1:1** The burden of the word of the LORD **to Israel** by Malachi.

---

---

**WATER BAPTISM** (We do not have a water baptism -- AT ALL!)

**1 Cor 1:17-18** For **Christ sent me NOT to baptize**, but to preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect.

18 For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

(Faith in Christ's blood (NOT water baptism) is NOW how we get our sins remitted.)

**Rom 3:24-25** Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

25 Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;

**WATER BAPTISM** (It was ALWAYS 'FOR' the remission of sins in the Bible, so ....

don't make it something it wasn't!

It was NEVER called 'a picture' of anything.

It was NEVER an option.

It was REQUIRED for EVERY person.

It was never said to be the FIRST STEP of OBEDIENCE, to SHOW salvation.)

**Mark 1:4** John did baptize in the wilderness, and preach the baptism of repentance FOR the remission of sins.

**Mark 16:16** He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

**Acts 2:38** Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ FOR the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

(WHY was Jesus water baptized? It was required, and He was taking the place of sinners. He did it 'to fulfil all righteousness.' Is THAT why you would do it, like Him?)

**Matt 3:13-15** Then cometh Jesus from Galilee to Jordan unto John, to be baptized of him.

14 But John forbad him, saying, I have need to be baptized of thee, and comest thou to me?

15 And Jesus answering said unto him, Suffer it to be so now: for thus it becometh us to fulfil all righteousness. Then he suffered him.

---

## **SPIRITUAL BAPTISM**

**Eph 4:5** One Lord, one faith, **one baptism**, (1+1=2 ... so 1 physical + 1 spiritual = 2)

**Col 2:12** Buried with him in baptism (God, spiritually, puts us into Christ at His death, to count it as payment for our sins), wherein also ye are risen with him (spiritual resurrection) through the faith (that is something you can NOT see) of the operation of God (that is who performs this baptism --- not a preacher), who hath raised him from the dead.

**Gal 3:27** For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ. (That is putting on the 'new man' in Eph 4:24 and Col 3:10.)

**Rom 6:3-4** Know ye not, that so many of us as were **baptized into Jesus Christ** (NOT water) were **baptized into his death**? (See Gal 2:20, "I am crucified with Christ")  
4 Therefore we are **buried with him by baptism into death**: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. (We also have a spiritual resurrection.)

**1 Cor 12:13** For by one Spirit (The Spirit baptizes us, Jesus does not do it) are we all baptized into one body, whether we be Jews or Gentiles, whether we be bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

**SPIRITUAL BAPTISM** (Israel had one also, but theirs is DIFFERENT from ours!)

**John 3:5** Jesus answered (Nicodemus), Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be **born of water** (water baptism) and of the Spirit (Spirit baptism), he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

(In John 3:10, "Jesus said unto him, Art thou a master of Israel, and knowest not these things?" The reason Nic should have known was because they were prophesied.)

**Ezek 36:25-27** Then will I sprinkle (not immerse) clean water upon you (that's born of water ... water baptism), and ye shall be clean: from all your filthiness, and from all your idols, will I cleanse you.

26 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh.

27 And I will put my spirit within you (that's born of Spirit ... Spirit baptism), and cause (make) you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them.

(John prophesied their Spirit Baptism .... that Jesus would do.)

**Matt 3:11** I (John, the baptizer) indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: he (Jesus) shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:

(When Jesus spiritually baptized them 'Jews' with the Holy Ghost, they ALL spoke with tongues. That was one of the SIGNS that would follow 'those that believe' in Mark 16:17, the 'Great Commission.')

**Acts 2:1-5** And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place.

2 And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting.

3 And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them.

4 And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

5 And there were dwelling at Jerusalem Jews, devout men, out of every nation under heaven.

**PHYSICAL HEALING** (We have 'inner' spiritual healing -- not 'outward' physical.)

**2 Cor 4:16** For which cause we faint not; but though our outward man perish, yet the inward man is renewed day by day.

(God gives strength to our 'insides' --- not our physical.)

**Eph 3:16** That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man;

(Timothy had digestive trouble and was sick alot.)

**1 Tim 5:23** Drink no longer water, but use a little wine for thy stomach's sake and thine often infirmities.

(Paul left a companion sick, and was unable to heal him.)

**2 Tim 4:20** Erastus abode at Corinth: but Trophimus have I left at Miletum sick.

**PHYSICAL HEALING** (God promised Israel physical healing.)

**Exo 15:26** And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I am the LORD that healeth thee.

**Matt 8:16** When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: (Jesus healed EVERY person that came to Him for healing.)

**Matt 9:35** And Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, and preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

**SPIRITUAL BLESSINGS** (Ours are spiritual --- Theirs are physical.  
We are already blessed --- no matter what!)

**Eph 1:3** Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who HATH blessed us with ALL spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ:

**PHYSICAL BLESSINGS** (The principal of the LAW was 'If ... Then' --- meaning  
IF they obeyed .... THEN God would bless them.  
IF they didn't ..... THEN God would curse them.

Israel's blessing from God was conditional upon their BEHAVIOR.)

**Deut 11:26-28** Behold, I set before you this day a blessing and a curse;  
27 A blessing, if ye obey the commandments of the LORD your God, which I command you this day:

28 And a curse, if ye will not obey the commandments of the LORD your God, but turn aside out of the way which I command you this day, to go after other gods, which ye have not known.

**Deut 28:2** And all these blessings shall come on thee, and overtake thee, IF thou shalt hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God. (The blessings are listed in vs. 3-14)

Deut 28:15 But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:

(The curses are listed in vs. 16-68.)

**John 8:31** Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed;

**Matt 24:13** But he that shall endure unto the end, the same shall be saved.

**Heb 3:6** But Christ as a son over his own house; whose house are we, IF we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm unto the end.

**Heb 3:14** For we are made partakers of Christ, IF we hold the beginning of our confidence stedfast unto the end;

**Heb 10:26** For IF we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins,

**1 John 2:3** And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.

**1 Cor 2:12** Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God. (under GRACE!)
