

Question # 4:

1 Cor 15:1-11 Moreover, brethren, I declare unto you the gospel which I preached unto you, which also ye have received, and wherein ye stand;

2 By which also ye are saved, if ye keep in memory what I preached unto you, unless ye have believed in vain.

3 For I delivered unto you first of all that which I also received, how that **Christ died for our sins according to the scriptures;**

4 And that he was buried, and that he rose again the third day according to the scriptures:

5 And that he was seen of **Cephas**, then of **the twelve**:

6 After that, he was seen of **above five hundred brethren** at once; of whom the greater part remain unto this present, but some are fallen asleep.

7 After that, he was seen of **James**; then of **all the apostles**.

8 And last of all he was seen of me also, as of one born out of due time.

9 For I am the least of the apostles, that am not meet to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God.

10 But by the grace of God I am what I am: and his grace which was bestowed upon me was not in vain; but I laboured more abundantly than they all: yet not I, but the grace of God which was with me.

11 Therefore **whether it were I (Paul)**

or they, (Cephas=Peter, the 12, over 500 brothers, James, and all the apostles)

so we (Paul AND Cephas=Peter, the 12, over 500 brothers, James, and all the apostles)

preach, and so ye believed.

4. Based on the passage 1 Cor 15:1-11, do you think Peter and Paul preached different gospels or did they preach the same gospel that Christ died for our sins, was buried, and rose again the 3rd day?

Please consider this: We regularly give the clear gospel from 1 Cor 15:1-4, but we have failed to read on through the passage to vs. 11, which states that Paul, and Cephas (Peter), the 12, over 500 brothers, James, and all the apostles, preached that gospel that Paul preached.
